Schönfelder Papierfabrik GmbH Policy Commitment „Use of wood from controlled sources“


Schönfelder Papierfabrik GmbH aims to avoid the use of wooden fibres which are classified in the FSC®-category „other fibres“

Non FSC®-certified fibres have to be classified in the category “Controlled Wood”.

According to this FSC®-category the purchased virgin fibres must not source from the following categories:

- illegally harvested wood;
- wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights;
- wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
- wood harvested in forests being converted to plantations or non- forest use;
- wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.

Schönfelder Papierfabrik GmbH will only use virgin fibres if our suppliers have a FSC-COC or FSC Controlled Wood certification or if we check the origin of the virgin fibres in accordance to the FSC®-Guidelines for FSC Controlled Wood (FSC-STD-40-005).
